What is CLLD Funding

- European Social Fund (ESF) part of European Structural Investment Funds (ESIF):
- Earmarked around £1million of ESF investment for Wisbech.
- Community-Led Local Development mechanism.

Projects to address 4 areas

- Poor employment opportunities, economic inactivity and work poverty
- Barriers to employment such as low aspiration, crisis, poor health, lack of basic skills and education
- Poorly integrated and marginalised people and communities
- Poor access to services, transport, information technology and advice

What it will deliver

- Unemployed participants into employment on leaving
- Inactive participants into employment or job search on leaving
- Participants into education or training on leaving

Requirements

- Deliver against the 4 development needs identified in the Local Development Strategy
- Minimum funding £10,000 = £20,000 project
- Have match funding in place 50% (10% Cash)
- Deliver the desired outcomes
- Offer Value for Money
